4: President's Report

There were no formal meetings in December or January, although plenty of work has been going on behind the scenes!

Our Christmas / End of Year function at Rifos was very well attended and greatly enjoyed by everyone: many thanks to Sue for organising the table decorations. Also a shout-out to Doruk at Rifos for the support he gives us and to his staff for their efficiency on the night. We have taken delivery of the very large touch screen that we were able to acquire with the grant from LotteryWest. This screen will be the interface for the digital mapping project and we are now experimenting with the functionalities inherent in the system. We are also undertaking the important process of ensuring that we have good quality information on the MHPA website. Loading data and QA of the inputs will take place over the next month or so and we should be ready to launch it for our Members in early May with a "Grand Public Launch" later that month. A short training session was also arranged by our IT advisor, Eddie Zhang.

We are now seeking further grant monies from LotteryWest to scan and digitise our paper records and some photographs. If these records are properly scanned and indexed, visitors will be able to do an effective key-word search throughout all of our collection. Information that emerges relating to our suburb can then be incorporated onto the website and linked through the digital map.

As a result of posts on social media, interest in our activities continues from within the local communities. In particular, over the last month or so we have had a lot of interaction with older residents who have had an association with Maylands Aerodrome. I am hopeful that we will be able to capture many of these memories, images and anecdotes to incorporate in some way in the redesigned aerodrome room to be re-launched later in the year.

Sue and I will be away on holiday until the middle of April but the other Volunteers will ensure that the monthly talks and the Open Days continue as usual.
