4.1: President's Report for December

My apologies for rearranging the Committee meeting this month – but it works out better this way as more of us can attend on the 2nd Wednesday

Our public talk in March featured Matt McVeigh and I think that everyone who attended was blown away by the range of his work and the intensity of his messages. This talk reflected his strong belief in social justice and important causes that he supports. I found it a fascinating talk with so many illustrations to absorb! At some time in the future I hope that we can add another “layer” to the digital map for “Artistic Maylands” and create pins for some (if not all!) of Matt’s public art installations – even though his does not have any public art in Maylands itself.

I am continuing to work with the Council of History West as well as the Affiliates Steering Committee, although progress on the strategic plan and revamped Merit Award is progressing slowly as I try to canvass the opinions of such a diverse set of people across the State

Although we are not able to organise and lead a formal ANZAC Day ceremony this year, we will be acknowledging the significance still in other ways: John will mount a temporary display of ANZAC-related stories on the external wall of the Old Police Station, I will give a talk at the RISE and we will also put up the small display, outside the Library, of personal stories that we have used before.

We decided this year not to apply for a grant from the Bendigo Bank Community fund, even though we had been successful for the last two years – in part because we have not managed to spend last year’s money

yet! It is down to me to finalise the design of the signage and banners and liaise with the City authorities to gain permission for the notice board.
